SINGING:

For singing parts (principals & ensemble), you need an appointment for your audition.

Prepare a short song (approx. 1 minute) in the style of the show. An accompanist will be available, but please bring the sheet music for your song. The emphasis should be on the singer's ability to clearly express the lyrical story. Singers may also be asked to sing a passage from one of the songs from the show. Musical sides for these selections will be posted to the website soon.

READING:

Reading auditions will be done on Wednesday, Dec 11, 11:00 am – 3:00 PM, on the Pinckney Hall Dance Floor. The readings will be done in pairs. [Reading sides can be found here.](#)

Please bring copies of all sides you will use for the audition.

DANCE:

ALL those auditioning for the show must attend the dance audition.

The dance auditions will be held Wednesday, Dec 11, 3:00 PM immediately following the reading auditions on the Pinckney Hall Dance Floor. Please be there and ready to begin by 3:00 PM.
